



# **Caribou Contests: Math Competition Instructions**

### Part 1: Guide

Follow the instructions given below to start the exam.


# On the Contest Day

- 1. Go to <a href="https://cariboutests.com/">https://cariboutests.com/</a> through Google Chrome or Firefox
- **2.** Click "START CONTEST" to enter the competition. The countdown on the upper right of the page will change to a big red START THE CONTEST.

(Alternatively, in the left-hand menu select Contests > Start the Contest)




Before beginning, the student must choose the language. To write the contest in English, click on 'English'.



3. The student must then log in before starting the contest. The student must first enter your individual access code. Click the button behind I wrote down my Access Code and continue.








Students will use the same access code throughout one school year.

If a student has logged in or written a contest this year already, you must enter the same access code.


4. If this is the first contest written with this access code, the student will be asked to confirm contest grade level and enter access code again. (Once confirmed or amended, this will be used as the grade for all rounds of exams in the current academic year)







5. Then the student will be prompted to enter your first and last name and agree to contest rules before continuing.



Enter your first name and last name twice. Check if you enter the information correctly. If you find that you could not log in, please try to enter your name in capital, your Chinese name, or your Chinese name in pinyin, or other alternative name.

6. Once the contest questions are opened, the student has 50 minutes to complete the test. There is a timer in the upper left corner so the student can see the time remaining.

Questions and options appear in random order so it is normal that two students do not have exactly the

7. When a student makes a selection, that selection is saved and submitted automatically. The message "You have answered this question." appears by the Next Arrow.



If the student wishes to change your answer, you must simply select your new answer.

Please Note: Question number will turn to green if you answer that question and submit successfully.





# 8. To end the contest, the student must click "End test". If time runs out, the test ends automatically.

Before ending the contest, the student should make sure you've submitted your answers for all the questions. A bad internet connection can stop a student's selections from being saved.

Even if the student does not manually end the test, all your selections are saved and will be submitted automatically when the 50 minutes run out, or after 30 minutes of inactivity.

9. To keep the contest fair, it is prohibited for students to interact during the exam, to do research on the internet, and to use a calculator. Students may use a pencil and paper for rough work.



10. After exam, you will see the reminder as below.



Or click 'My Account Information', scroll down to icons and click on 'My Contest Results' for individual contests.








# **VIEW MY CONTEST RESULTS**

You can see Statistics and Rankings for a certain contest, level, or the Caribou Cup under Results in the main menu.




