

Caribou Contests: Math Competition Instructions

Part 1: Guide

Follow the instructions given below to start the exam.

On the Contest Day

1. Go to <https://cariboutests.com/> through Google Chrome or Firefox
 2. Click “START CONTEST” to enter the competition. The countdown on the upper right of the page will change to a big red START THE CONTEST.
- (Alternatively, in the left-hand menu select Contests > Start the Contest)



Before beginning, the student must choose the language. To write the contest in English, click on ‘English’.

3. The student must then log in before starting the contest. The student must first enter your individual access code. Click the button behind I wrote down my Access Code and continue.

- You must use the same Access Code for every contest in this Caribou Cup (Oct-May).
- After the 2nd contest day, sign in with your Access Code to see your results.

Important Instructions

- To navigate, use the Next Arrow and Question Links. Do not use your browser's Back Button.
- Your test will end after 50 minutes. If your computer or browser crashes, you can log in to resume your test.
- If you lose time due to technical problems, your Caribou Coordinator (teacher) can help you.
- If you finish early, you can end your test. You will not be able to resume the test if you do this.

Please Note:


Enter your first name and last name twice. Check if you enter the information correctly. If you find that you could not log in, please try to enter your name in capital, your Chinese name, or your Chinese name in pinyin, or other alternative name.

6. Once the contest questions are opened, the student has **50 minutes** to complete the test. There is a timer in the upper left corner so the student can see the time remaining.

Questions and options appear in random order so it is normal that two students do not have exactly the same test.

7. When a student makes a selection, that selection is saved and submitted automatically. The message “**You have answered this question.**” appears by the Next Arrow.

8. To end the contest, the student must click “End test”. If time runs out, the test ends automatically.

Before ending the contest, the student should make sure you’ve submitted your answers for all the questions. A bad internet connection can stop a student’s selections from being saved.

Even if the student does not manually end the test, all your selections are saved and will be submitted automatically when the 50 minutes run out, or after 30 minutes of inactivity.

9. To keep the contest fair, it is prohibited for students to interact during the exam, to do research on the internet, and to use a calculator. Students may use a pencil and paper for rough work.



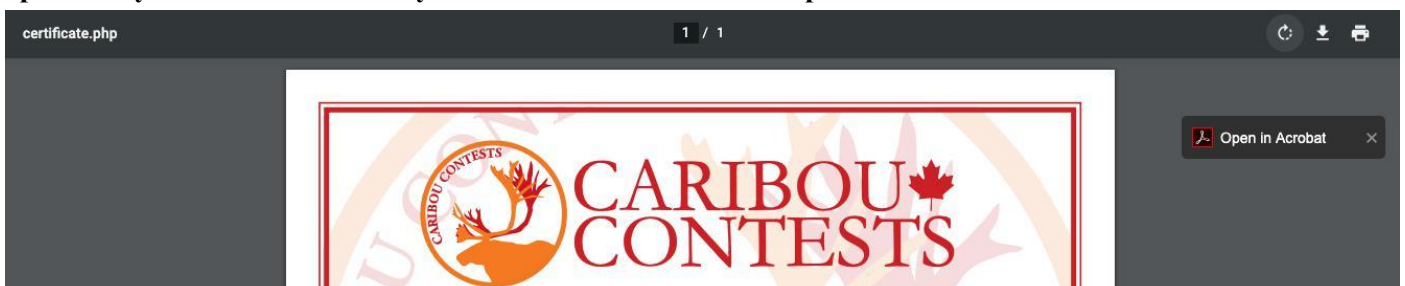
