Shanghai, located on the eastern coast of China, is a vibrant metropolis that seamlessly blends historical charm with modern vitality. The city boasts iconic landmarks such as the classical Yuyuan Garden and the historic City God Temple, both reflecting Shanghai's rich cultural heritage. Stroll along the Bund to admire the colonial-era architecture lining the Huangpu River. For nature lovers, the Shanghai Natural History Museum offers over 11,000 specimens, a walk-through African savanna, and immersive theaters.

Assemble at designated hotel and board the bus from 8:30am to 9am (subject to actual notification).

**Yuyuan Garden:** a renowned classical Jiangnan garden and a famous historical and cultural site. It was designated a "National Key Cultural Relic Protection Unit" by the State Council in 1982.

**Shanghai City God Temple:** This Taoist temple has a long history and rich cultural atmosphere. First built in the Ming Dynasty and renovated multiple times, it has become an important cultural landmark and tourist attraction in Shanghai.

**Shanghai Natural History Museum:** displays over 11,000 specimen models from seven continents. A nearly 1,500-square-meter walk-through diorama vividly recreates the vibrant African savanna. The "Time Travellers" features over 200 animal and plant specimens from different eras and regions worldwide. Five immersive theaters, including "Escape from the Cretaceous," recreate major events in evolutionary history.

**The Bund:** Located on the banks of the Huangpu River, stretching about 1.5 kilometers, it is an iconic attraction of Shanghai. Its essence lies in the diverse colonial-era buildings along the waterfront and the view of the river.

Expected to return to the hotel by bus before 5:30pm.

\* Due to the uncertainty of ticket reservations for the Shanghai Natural History Museum, if tickets cannot be purchased for objective reasons, the visit will be replaced with the China Maritime Museum.
